The competition is open to Doctoral candidates and postgraduate scholars at an early stage of their academic careers (within five years of completing their degrees).

The deadline for applications to the Desautels Review Paper Competition is **28 February, 2022**. Applicants should include a cover letter, scholarly paper, and curriculum vitae to the attention of the Editor-in-Chief of the Desautels Review.
